

**ATLANTIC TELEPHONE MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION**  
**64th ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MEMBERS**

October 1, 2021

Members of Atlantic Telephone Membership Corporation held their 64th Annual Meeting on Friday, October 1, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Odell Williamson Auditorium located on the campus of Brunswick Community College in Bolivia, North Carolina with 2507 members registered out of 43,600 total members, therefore meeting the quorum requirement of 436. Members began registration and voting either by mail or electronically by email September 9, 2021 at 12:00 a.m. through September 29, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. The registration and voting process was conducted by a third-party vendor, Survey Ballots & Systems, and all registration and voting had to be submitted through their registration and voting process.

The business meeting was called to order after the invocation and pledge of allegiance given by Harry Conrad Bryant, III at 7:00 p.m. by James H. Milliken, Board of Directors President. President Milliken recognized each of the ATMC Directors, CEO/General Manager, and Corporate Attorney who were in the audience.

The Report of 2507 members registering out of 43,600 total members was presented by Napoleon Barefoot, Corporate Attorney, in order to determine the existence of a quorum supported by the Affidavit of registrar, Rhonda Gray. The reading of the Notice of the Meeting and proof of the due publication by mailing and/or emailing the 43,600 notices, as verified by affidavit of the registrar, Rhonda Gray, was presented by Napoleon Barefoot, Corporate Attorney. The minutes of the 63rd Annual Meeting of the members held on October 1, 2020 were read by Napoleon Barefoot, Corporate Attorney and approved by the registered members.

President Milliken gave the Directors' Report including remarks about the current year return to the members of their patronage through capital credit payments to members.

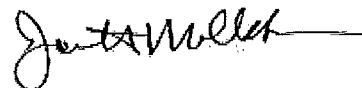
Michael Keith Holden, Chief Executive Officer gave the Manager's Report highlighting recent activities of the cooperative.

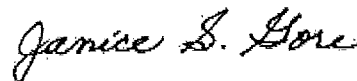
