Always Call Before You Dig

April is National Safe Digging month and if you are planning a home improvement project, make sure to call 811 before you dig. Simple tasks like installing a mailbox, planting shrubbery, or building a deck can result in damage to gas, electric, communications or water and sewer lines, which can lead to service disruptions. Not knowing where these utility services are in your yard could also lead to serious injuries and costly repairs if digging is done without knowing their location.

By calling 811 before you dig, you'll be connected to a local one call notification center that will share your information with local utility companies like FOCUS Broadband. Locators will then visit the dig site to mark the approximate location of underground utility lines with spray paint, flags, or both. Once a site has been accurately marked, you'll be able to safely begin digging.
