ATMC grant helps Brunswick County students

ATMC recently awarded a Community Connections grant to the Waterway Arts Association, a local non-profit organization serving artists in the area. Understanding the importance of providing the youth in Brunswick County with art supplies, the Waterway Arts Association used the ATMC grant to purchase these supplies, which they donated to the Brunswick County high schools. Barbara Clark, Vice President of the Waterway Arts Association, says high schools are given a set amount of money for art programs based on how many students are involved, and teachers typically have to resort to fundraisers, art sales, and other methods to raise funds for additional supplies – but this year they won't have to do that.

"For a local company like ATMC to help us with this mission is a tremendous help to the whole county and it promotes what we're trying to do, and enables us

to do so much more," Clark said. "We were absolutely thrilled with this grant from ATMC." Over the years, ATMC has awarded more than \$845,000 to over 507 programs, benefiting thousands of lives.
