

Save the Date for ATMC's Annual Meeting of Members

Mark your calendar now and make plans to attend ATMC's 64th Annual Meeting of Members at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, October 1st, 2021, at the Odell Williamson Auditorium on the campus of Brunswick Community College. Even though last year's Annual Meeting was held virtually due to COVID-19 restrictions, we experienced a tremendous increase in member participation because of a new online voting and registration process.

As a result of last year's success, ATMC will once again conduct member registration and voting online and by mail. Members who have opted to receive their ATMC monthly billing statement electronically will receive their annual meeting notice via email along with instructions on how to cast their vote, should there be a contested election. Those who receive a paper copy of their monthly billing statement will receive registration information and a mail-in ballot by mail. Registration materials will be sent out via email and mail on September 9th.

Mandatory Ten Digit Dialing Coming this Fall

ATMC telephone customers should now dial 10-digits when making local calls. Calls made dialing just seven digits will still go through until October 24th. After that time, calls made dialing just seven digits will not be completed. This change is taking place nationally to make way for the National Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Crisis Lifeline which will make it easier for anyone in a mental health crisis to receive help.

Customers are encouraged to make sure that all important safety and security equipment is reprogrammed to use 10-digit dialing and contact information used on personal and business materials such as checks and advertising is updated to include the 910 area code.
