ATMC's 64th Annual Meeting of Members will take place at 7 p.m. on October 1st at Odell Williamson Auditorium. As a result of ongoing concerns related to the transmission of COVID-19, a dinner will not be served. Registration and voting will be conducted online and by mail.

Instructions on how to register and cast votes will be sent out on September 9th via email to members who have opted to receive their ATMC monthly billing statement electronically. Those who receive a paper copy of their monthly billing statement will receive registration information and a mail-in ballot by mail. Registration and voting will end on September 29th. The three current board members, John W. "Buster" Dowless, R. Gene Ward, and Albert H. "Al" Parker, Jr. are running unopposed.

- Drop your payment off in one of our drop box locations at our Shallotte or Sunset Beach stores.
- Make your payment at our Shallotte office using our drive-thru window.

Capital Credits Reminder

As a reminder, Capital Credit disbursements will go out this month to past and present members who had qualifying service in 1998, 1999 and/or 2020. Members with a disbursement of more than \$50 will receive a check, members who receive a disbursement of \$50 or less will see the disbursement applied in the form of a credit on their September billing statement.

Mandatory 10 Digit Dialing Starts Next Month



ATMC telephone customers should now dial 10-digits when making local calls. Calls made dialing just seven digits will still go through until October 24th. After that time, calls made dialing just seven digits will not be completed.

Customers are encouraged to make sure that all important safety and security equipment is reprogrammed to use 10-digit dialing. Contact information used on personal and business materials such as checks, and advertising should be updated to include the 910 area code. For more information, visit atmc.com/10digitdialing.
