

How To Spot The Latest Scams: Scam Calls & Misleading Search Results

We want to advise customers about multiple ongoing scams designed to obtain account and personal information, including attempts to change, cancel, or even switch services to other providers. In some cases, technicians from other companies have even been dispatched. These scams involve unsolicited phone calls from individuals falsely claiming to work for FOCUS Broadband, as well as misleading sponsored search results that display phone numbers appearing to be our Repair or Customer Service lines but instead direct customers to a third-party call center.

Here's what you need to know. FOCUS Broadband will never:

- Call you from a toll-free number. Legitimate calls will come from a NC area code (910) followed by a Brunswick County prefix (755 or 754).
- Tell you that you must switch to another internet provider or that we are affiliated with another national internet service provider (Spectrum, AT&T, etc.).
- Request personal or account information during unsolicited calls.
- Call you from a third-party call center. Our call center and representatives are based in the United States and are not handled overseas.

If something doesn't feel right, trust your instincts and don't share any personal information. Hang up immediately and **contact FOCUS Broadband using the verified phone number on your bill or at focusbroadband.com.** As scam tactics continue to evolve, FOCUS Broadband will keep you informed.

Fiber Optic Service Coming to Sunset Beach

FOCUS Broadband is continuing to expand our fiber-to-the-home network to members with a new project underway on the island of Sunset Beach.

The project is expected to be completed by Memorial Day and conversion of approximately 1,400 homes and businesses to the new network will follow. Once complete, customers on Sunset Beach will have access to multi-gig internet speeds delivered over a 100% fiber-to-the-home connection. Customers will receive notification by mail or email when fiber optic service becomes available at their address.

Additional areas are on tap to be converted to fiber optics this year and will be announced in the coming months.
