

Completed USDA Grant Brings Fiber to Columbus County

FOCUS Broadband completed a project which has made high-speed internet service available for more than 2,700 homes and businesses in rural parts of Columbus County. Now, many living in previously unserved areas surrounding Tabor City, Hallsboro, Bolton, Lake Waccamaw, and Whiteville have access to gigabit broadband speeds. Bringing high-speed internet access to these areas was made possible by \$7.9 million in ReConnect grant funds awarded to FOCUS Broadband by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) in December of 2019.



"We know having access to high-speed internet will have a tremendous impact on these rural communities, allowing them to

work remotely and connect to important resources like telehealth and eLearning," said Keith Holden, FOCUS Broadband CEO. "We are incredibly grateful for the support of USDA, county officials, and residents of Columbus County who worked with us throughout the project."

In other areas of Columbus County near Evergreen, Acme-Delco, Riegelwood, and Prosper FOCUS Broadband is using grant funds awarded by the North Carolina GREAT Grant program to expand high-speed internet access to even more unserved areas.
